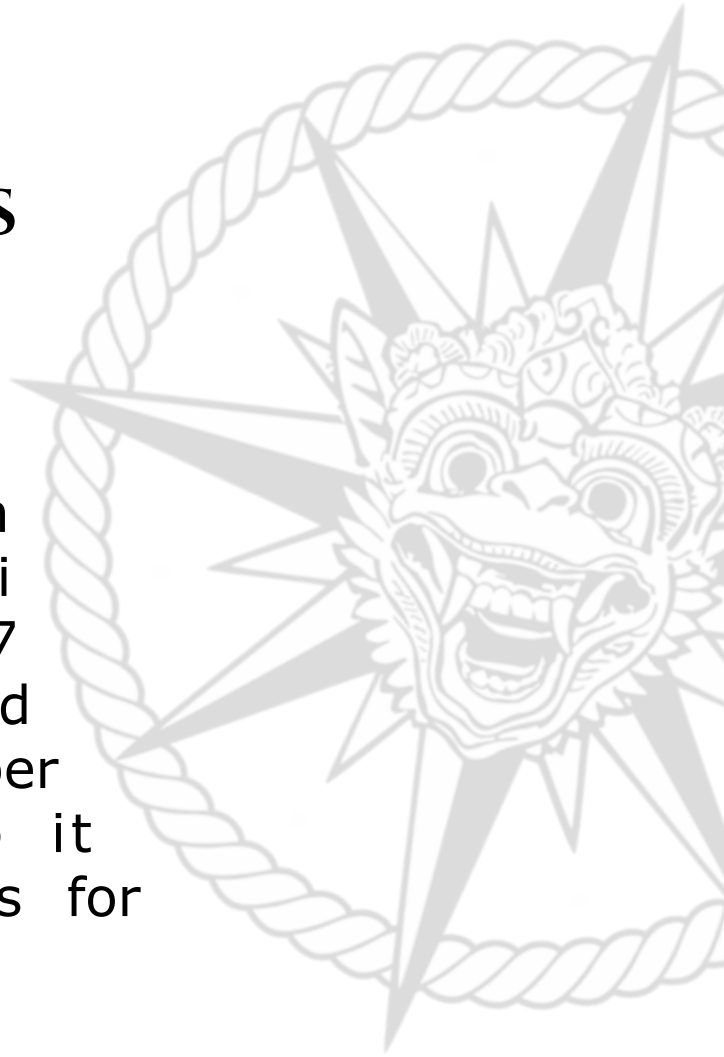


MAKI BOAT CABINS

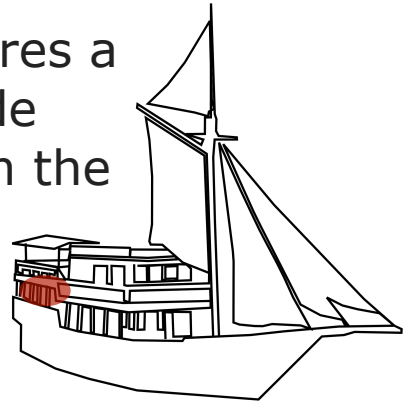

DIVE IN FOR A RUN DOWN OF EACH CABIN

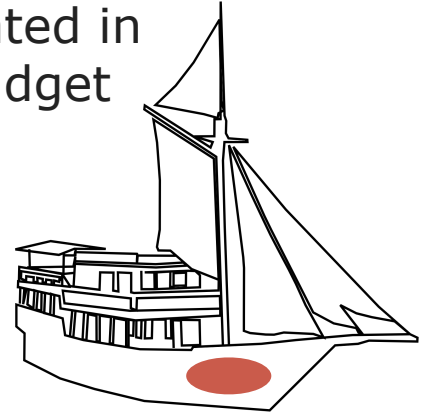
THE MASTER ENSUITE

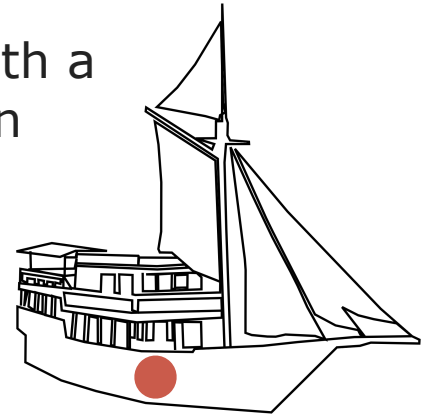
ROOM 1:

5 pax dorm with its own toilet. Located in the bottom level at the bow. it is our budget option, but still comfortable for a boat. perfect for groups of friends who don't mind sharing a space and having a laugh at night lying in bed surfed out. it features a nice and strong a/c enough to keep everyone cool.



ROOM 2:

This room features a double bed with a bunk single bed above it, It is located in the bottom level, close to the center of gravity. It doesn't have a private bathroom but there is a bathroom directly in front of its door.

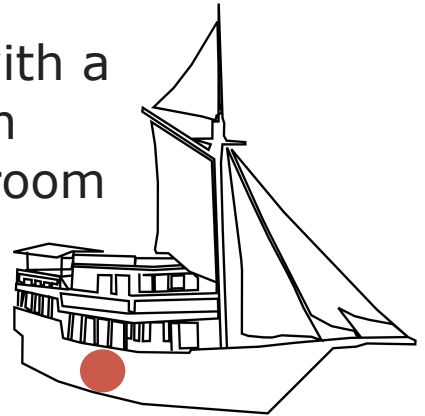


It suits couples or friends traveling together.



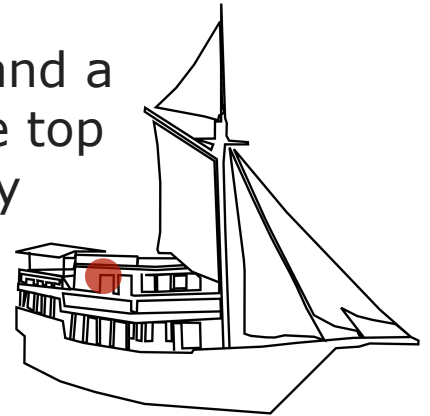
ROOM 3:

private en-suite with a double bed with a bunk single bed above it. besides its own bathroom, It also has more space than room 2 and a small desk with a mirror. Located at the bottom level, first door as you go downstairs.



ROOM 4:

private en-suite with a double bed and a bunk single bed above it. Located at the top level behind the captain cabin. Definitely one of the best rooms.
